SHERIDAN CHRISTMAS CARDS NOW READY TO ORDER FOR 2009

SHERIDAN, IND.—Customized Christmas greeting cards featuring Sheridan and wild creatures around Boxley Cabin are now available for order and featuring new artwork designed by David Ogle.

The Sheridan Historical Society, which started the tradition several years ago, is now making the cards available for a donation of \$13 for a set of 10 cards with envelopes, or \$1.50 per card. All proceeds benefit the society, a not-for-profit organization that is actively producing heritage-based educational and cultural programs as well as developing a master plan for new structures in Sheridan Veterans Park.

According to Ginny Tackitt, “We need orders in early to have the special cards delivered by the holidays. Each year we are so excited to see the colorful art that David Ogle has created and the changing focus of the design. The 2009 cards feature blue jays and cardinals as well as two white-tailed squirrels that came to Sheridan last spring and made their home near Boxley Cabin,” she recapped. “They entertained us all summer with their bright white tails and attracted many people who came to investigate the uncommon breed.”
